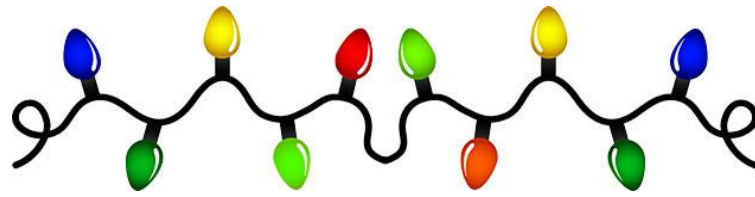




PTFA Christmas Update.
