Really tough times are ahead for us but you may be able to help

Central Govt is proposing a new funding formula for Education that will mean a big cut to our school's budget. It will be £121,000 each year, which is approx 9% of our total income and equates to a cut of £312 per child or a cut of 3 teachers! For the Thornton Primary School cluster it equates to a loss of £548,000 and a loss to Lancashire of just over £68 million pounds each year. Obviously, this will have a major impact on opportunities and provision for our children across the Authority. School leaders are working alongside the professional associations to lobby the Govt. If you feel that this new formula is wrong then it is an opportunity for you to lobby the two local MPs regarding the proposed cuts too. Thank you for any support you can give.
