In the morning the children, along with 5 other local schools, took part in a singing workshop and learned a challenging 3 part harmony piece that was to be performed at the concert that same afternoon! ## World Culture Day

**In Reception** we; Learnt Frere a Jacques, learnt a French dance, discussed and compared food, wrote a postcard from France, counted to 10 in French, compared Blackpool Tower and The Eiffel Tower and listened to Jack and The Beanstalk in French and compared it to the version we know.

**In Year 4** we tasted pancakes, played hockey and baseball and found out all about the country. We interviewed Mr Mack's auntie who lives in Canada and asked her lots of questions.

**In Year3** we have been learning about the Chinese Terracotta Army. In 1974, Workers digging a well outside the city of Xi'an, China made an extraordinary discovery of some broken pieces of terracotta armoured warriors.

More than 8,000 life-sized Terracotta Warriors were unearthed in burial pits at the tomb complex of Emperor, Qin Shi Huang. They found a massive army of clay warriors which were built to protect Qin as he believed in life after death. Every single soldier is unique, there are no two alike, their facial expressions, hair style, posture, all denoting their position and rank within the army. We have learnt that China's famous Terracotta Warriors are to be exhibited in Liverpool in 2018.
